Congratulations, you have now completed the Family Mediation training course, which is one of the electives in the Institute of Peace and Conflict Studies' Certificate Program in Conflict Management, offered through Conrad Grebel University College and the University of Waterloo. This will be registered as your first workshop in the program, and we invite you to consider taking more workshops that will add to your options for how to resolve conflict in creative and positive ways.

Workshops may be taken for interest or to obtain a Certificate in Conflict Management and Mediation. To receive a basic Certificate we require a total of 7 workshops, with a minimum of 19 days instruction, including two mandatory workshops. Please note that Family Mediation qualifies for 7 days of instruction and is valued at 2 workshops. For an Advanced Certificate in Conflict Management and Mediation a minimum of 8 workshops and 22 days of instruction must be completed including the workshop entitled "Advanced Family Mediation Skills".
