Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Levels:

- Level A:** One-rescuer CPR and choking manoeuvres for an adult casualty
- Level B:** One-rescuer CPR and choking manoeuvres for adult, child and infant casualties
- Level C:** One and two-rescuer CPR and choking manoeuvres for adult, child and infant casualties
- HCP:** One and two-rescuer CPR and choking manoeuvres for adult, child and infant casualties. AR, BVM, AED included
- Level E:** Customized courses that provide training for special needs group
- AED:** Understanding the knowledge and skill to safely use an AED(Automated External Defibrillator)

Annual retraining in CPR is recommended
