Congratulations, you have now completed the Family Mediation training course, which is one of the electives in the Institute of Peace and Conflict Studies' Certificate Program in Conflict Management, offered through Conrad Grebel University College and the University of Waterloo. This will be registered as your first workshop in the program, and we invite you to consider taking more workshops that will add to your options for how to resolve conflict in creative and positive ways.

Workshops may be taken for interest or to obtain a Certificate in Conflict Management and Mediation. To receive a basic Certificate, 7 workshops, with a minimum of 133 hours, are necessary—"Understanding Conflict I: The Key to Change" and "Communication in Creative Leadership" are the two required core workshops; the others are electives. Please note that Family Mediation qualifies for 49 hours and is valued at 2 workshops. For an Advanced Certificate in Conflict Management and Mediation a minimum of 8 workshops (154 hours) must be completed including the workshop entitled "Advanced Mediation Skills" or "Advanced Family Mediation Skills".

Please note that as a participant in this course, you will periodically receive information about upcoming courses in the Certificate Program in Conflict Management, also enclosed is a registration form for your convenience.
