Narrative:

History:

On the 17th day of August, 2023, the accused, Markeen AGNEW, entered into a Youth Sentence Order before the Honourable Justice C.C Belda. The Order conditions include but are not limited to:

- Keep the peace and be of good behaviour
- Be in your place of residence between the hours of 8:00pm and 8:00am daily

On the 15th day of May, 2023, The accused, Paris BOUCHARD, entered into a Form 11 Release Order before Justice of the Peace T Meyer. The Order conditions include but are not limited to:

- Remain in your residence daily between the hours of 7:00am and 7:00pm daily
- Do not contact or communicate in anyway either directly or indirectly by any physical electronic or other means with: Markenna AGNEW, Neveah AGNEW, Shyra DESMOULIN.

On the 10th day of January, 2024, The accused, Greg TOWEGISHIG, entered into a Recognizance before the Honourable Justice E.A Burton. The recognizance conditions include but are not limited to:

- Keep the peace and be of good behaviour

Investigation:

On the 11th day of February, 2024, in the Municipality of Greenstone, in the District of Thunder Bay, the Greenstone OPP were dispatched to a report of a break and enter in progress at 129 Skinner Ave in Longlac. The complainant, Candice PAQUETTE, called to report that she is watching the dwelling on behalf of the owner and there are 5 kids that have broken into the house. PAQUETTE was familiar with all the youths from her employment and identified them as: Markenna AGNEW, Neveah AGNEW, Paris BOUCHARD, Shyra DESMOULIN and Greg TOWEGISHIG. PC Borek and First Nation Constable Mccollum were en route when they were provided an update that the youths had left the dwelling.

PC Borek located the youths on foot on the corner of Dr Dean Drive and Picnic Point Road in Longlac. PC Borek exited his vehicle, identified himself as a police officer and directed the youths to stop. Markenna AGNEW fled on foot and was pursued by PC Borek. Markenna was placed under arrest by PC Borek and brought back to the force vehicle. While attempting to place Markenna in the vehicle she actively resisted, became combative and kicked PC Borek in the leg. Markenna was eventually placed in the vehicle and PC Borek was joined by FNC Mccollum who had TOWEGISHIG and Neveah AGNEW under arrest. The remaining youths, BOUCHARD and DESMOULIN evaded police.

PC Borek attended the scene and spoke with the complainant. PAQUETTE informed PC Borek that she was asked by Noreen AGNEW, the owner of the dwelling, to watch it while she is out of town. Noreen was explicitly clear that no one, including Neveah and Markenna, are allowed at the house without supervision. PAQUETTE informed PC Borek that she attended the house and found the youths inside drinking. PAQUETTE spoke with Noreen and then called police at Noreen's direction. PC Borek observed that the front and rear door had been broken and rendered unusable by the youths while attempting to gain entry into the dwelling. PAQUETTE

advised that the other youths may be headed to the Long Lake 58 lodge and police should attend there.

PC Borek attended the Long Lake 58 lodge located at 106 Lake Street in Longlac. PC Borek located BOUCHARD and DESMOULIN there and placed them both under arrest.

All youths were read their rights to counsel and caution which they understood. All youths were found in possession of alcohol and cannabis and were under the influence of alcohol and/or cannabis at the time of their arrests.

A CPIC query was conducted that revealed multiple active conditions for most of the youths.

As a result, the accused, Greg TOWEGISHIG is charged with:

CC 348(1)(b) Break, Enter dwelling house - commit indictable offence (TOWEGISHIG, Greg) (E240170501)

Greg TOWEGISHIG did break, entering a dwelling house located at 129 Skinner Ave in Longlac and committed the indictable offence of mischief by destroying the front and rear door.

CC 811 Breach of Recognizance (TOWEGISHIG, Greg) (E240170501)

Greg TOWEGISHIG did breach his Recognizance by failing to keep the peace and be of good behaviour.
