He said he has flown often and travelled by bus and train also. His Mom Patsy Calhoun in Milville has agreed to pick him up in Fredericton at the airport. He is getting blood work for his schizophrenia but the Salvation Army worker Trena Reid said that would take some extended time and effort to have him medicated and expressed that the sooner he leaves it would be appreciated. I have left a message with his adopted Mom to see if she can look after that when he lands. I'm sure that will be OK but I will confirm with her. His birth Mom has also expressed a desire to help Anthony once he gets home. He asked to get him a flight home ASAP. I am going to wait for approval for this DTP before booking a flight which is about \$800 depending on the day. Walter Slipperjack will pick him up at 6:30 a.m. for the airport.
