Flight out at 8:15 a.m. Client and Addictions worker both very appreciative and thankful for assistance provided by NAN. Addictions Worker from Fort Albany Tonya Munro asked NAN Legal to provide taxis for a few days in Timmins so that Michael could receive assistance in applying for addictions treatment. Four taxis were booked in total. Tonya was unable to secure assistance at Monteith Correctional Centre while client was incarcerated to assist him with applications to attend treatment. Savings on hotel rooms allowed taxis for the week. This worker assisted at the request of Tonya who works closely with our Chief in Fort Albany.
