CHECK-IN TIMES

- Passengers must be at the airport for all flights 90 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.
- Flights departing Quebec close 60 minutes prior to departure, all other flights close 45 minutes prior to departure to allow sufficient time for pre-flight procedures.
- Passengers who arrive after the required check-in times may be denied boarding.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

- Passengers are entitled to no more than 30 kg of checked baggage when traveling on scheduled flights aboard a Boeing 737, a DHC-8 (Dash-8-100 or -300) or a DHC-6 (Twin Otter) and 20 kg when traveling on scheduled flights aboard a Beechcraft-300 (King Air).
- If the itinerary includes a same-day transfer from one type of aircraft to another with different allowances, the 30 kg allowance will apply.
- Additional weight will be considered as excess baggage and be subject to additional charges. Excess baggage will be transported on a space-available basis.

CARRY-ON BAGGAGE

- Size and weight are a Transport Canada regulation.
- Each passenger is allowed **one (1) piece of cabin baggage** of a **maximum of 5 kg**.
- Maximum size allowed: 9 inches X 14.5 inches X 20 inches.
- Exceptions of maximum size allowed on:
 - Twin Otter: 9 inches X 13 inches X 13 inches,
 - King Air: 8 inches X 12 inches X 13 inches.
- Cabin baggage must fit **without exception** within the sizing device at the check-in counter otherwise it will have to be checked-in (even at the boarding gate).

REGIONAL AIR ACCESS PROGRAM (PAAR/RAAP) NOTICE
