Structured Cabling T&C

1. Standard office environments, i.e. - 9-foot t-bar ceilings are included. Office areas with drywall or other fixed ceilings, where access is limited or not available, may incur additional labour/material charges if required. This includes all office areas within warehouses or manufacturing plants, with the exception of office modules located in the plant area that requires cabling to be installed through the plant.

2. Non-standard office environments are included in this proposal. Pricing for these areas are affected by a variety of environmental, distance, height and safety considerations that may only be identified at the time of installation. Cabling costs for these areas are typically higher than those identified in the standard office pricing schedule. EWEE NS, reserves the right to re-price or quote work specific to the particular site/environmental requirements of the requested installation.

3. This pricing model does not include installations in historical buildings or buildings of non-standard construction, i.e. temporary facilities, post and beam construction, barns, etc.

4. Work requested under this agreement shall be completed during regular business hours (8AM-5PM Monday to Friday).

5. If a work order is executed that requires Off-Shift, Premium or Overtime labour to complete, the cost of the labour portion of the cable drop package will be incremented to reflect the portion of the work completed at that rate, otherwise straight Time & Material rates will be utilized.

6. EWEE NS can accommodate Off-Shift work at Regular Time labour rates if the work is scheduled & confirmed, 7 or more business days in advance; however, cancellation charges may apply if the scheduled work is subsequently cancelled.

7. The rental of mechanized lift equipment which, is required, for warehouse / plants with ceiling heights over 18 feet is not included, as these costs vary from region to region within Canada. EWEE NS can provide region by region pricing if requested.

8. Cabling installations are to follow category 5e & category 6 design guidelines and installation practices. Both the vendor and manufacturer will certify all installations meet category 5e & category 6 standards.

9. All cabling will be installed into existing facilities - i.e. conduit, cable tray and cable pathways. Ewee Inc a assumes that there will be sufficient space to allow for the additional cabling as requested.

10. Hazardous materials present in or found to be present in any workspaces are the sole responsibility of the owner. EWEE NS assumes no responsibility to correct or otherwise make the area safe. It is the customer's / owner's responsibility to make the area safe for EWEE NS' contractors and employees prior to the completion of the work.

11. EWEE NS' pricing assumes that we will not be delayed excessively (more than $\frac{1}{2}$ hour) at a site to coordinate the cabling installation.

12. The proposal includes all anticipated travel expenses to complete work as specified in one continuous visit. Additional work & return visits, outside of the scope of this document may incur additional travel & per diem charges. This will only apply if changes to the job occur which require a return trip and/or additional time on site that is approved in advance through the change process.

13. Cable labelling is to follow the Client established standard for all new cable installations, regardless of what is already in place at the facility. If no labelling standard is present at the facility, EWEE NS will recommend a strategy based upon the current ANSI/TIA/EIA Telecommunications Administration

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Standard to the customer.

14. EWEE NS welcomes additional work requested over and above the original request at any location; however, it is to be authorized by the customer by way of a change request and authorization code, from the site, prior to additional work being undertaken.
