Request for EXPEDITED PROCESSING OF A VULNERABLE SECTOR CHECK TO SUPPORT INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAMMING

To whom it may concern,

A VSC is required to grant access to the person named above to enter the Kenora jail to conduct Gladue interviews

As stated, these responsibilities place an employee in a position of trust and authority over vulnerable individuals and therefore the Ministry determined that the duties of the position meet the test as outlined in section 6.3 (1) of the *Criminal Records Act* as the person who, because of his or her age, disability or other circumstances, whether temporary or permanent, would be placed in a position of dependency on the employee, and others. Failure to obtain a VSC would put these persons at risk.

The ministry is requesting that this individual's application for the VSC be considered as part of the identified exempt group and processed according to the All Chiefs Memo, dated March 23, 2020 - **Prioritizing Police Record Checks** from the Assistant Deputy Minister, Public Safety Division and Public Safety Training Division, Ministry of the Solicitor General.

"In support of this public health mandate and the well-being of Ontarians, the ministry is also requesting police services to expedite police record checks, where it is required, for all essential workers, including health care personnel, social service workers, child care workers, and individuals involved in food supply and the maintenance of critical infrastructure."

It is understood that the hardcopy results of an individual's VSC may be returned to the individual and it is at their discretion as to whether they wish to submit the results of the check to their potential employer. Written consent to disclose the results of the check to the potential employer is also required under employer policy.
